of attendees shared that culture change will be the **hardest challenge to overcome moving into 2020**.

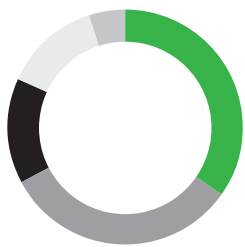
38%

Top 5 job titles



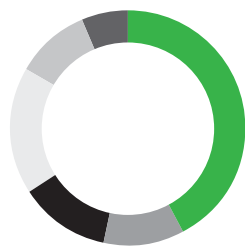
